Geraldine Virginia Kerger (nee Emmons) 87, of South Baltimore transitioned to her heavenly home after a battle with cancer on October 19, 2023. Geraldine was born on November 29, 1935 to Katherine and Nelson Emmons. After graduating from Southern High School in 1953, she married John Kerger on October 8, 1955 at Holy Cross Catholic Church. The couple had three children, two girls and a boy born on their fourth anniversary. She spent most of her married life being a mother homemaker and later running her own childcare business. Once retired, she took care of her mother and joined several clubs including the Allen Center in her mother's memory. She was a kind, warm, and loving woman, who enjoyed walking and spending time with her friends, including her best friend and neighbor of over 60 years. She was a lifelong Christian and member of the Old Otterbein Methodist Church.
